

UMD Global LEAD Scholarship Application

DESCRIPTION AND ELIGIBILITY

The University of Minnesota Duluth (UMD) is committed to creating a diverse academic community and is pleased to invite qualified undergraduate international students to apply for the International Global LEAD (Leadership, Excellence, Achievement, and Diversity) Scholarship. This scholarship is valued up to \$3,000 annually, and awarded on a competitive basis to students who meet the following criteria:

- Demonstrate leadership and describe their unique talents, or skills they will share with the UMD community
- Newly admitted, undergraduate degree-seeking international student
- Active, non-immigrant temporary visa status
- Students who qualify for in-state tuition, reciprocity or any other tuition reduction plan are ineligible

The scholarship is renewed annually, contingent upon maintenance of 3.0 cumulative University of Minnesota (U of M) GPA, and full-time undergraduate status. Students who have previously attended a college/university will be eligible to receive this award for three years while new high school students will be eligible to receive their award for four years, subject to previously mentioned renewal criteria.

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

Students who wish to be considered for the scholarship must:

- Submit their completed UMD application for admission, application fee and supporting admission documents by April 15, 2021 for Fall semester 2021 or November 15 for Spring 2022
- Must be a full-time degree-seeking undergraduate international student on a non-immigrant, temporary visa
- Submit the completed UMD Global LEAD application form on the following page along with a personal statement
